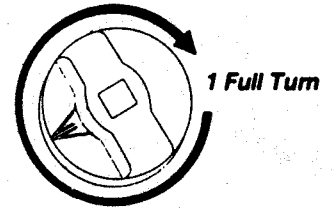


MOUSE MASTER

The Multiple-Catch Mousetrap that is Convenient and Easy to Use

1 Remove label from inside trap and adhere in most convenient location for your recording.

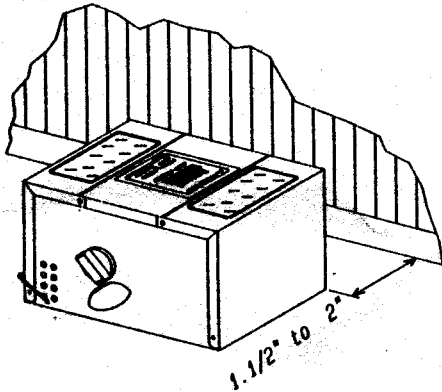
2 Depress shaft end and hold in until completely unwound. Wind trap 8 to 10 full revolutions (360°). Ten full revolutions generate up to 15 mice catching release of the paddle wheel. **NOTE:** Make sure knob is flush against metal side while winding.



3 Place "MOUSE MASTER" close to a wall where you suspect mice to be running. Here are two suggestions:

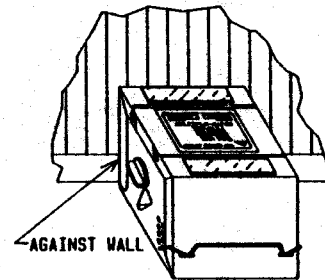
"A"

When mice are indoors and are moving from one hiding place to another, place the trap 1-1/2" to 2" from a warm surface wall, with either entrance tunnel facing the wall.



"B"

When mice are moving to the inside or might be under stress to seek rapid safety, place the back tight against the wall with tunnel exposure on both sides. This is a good method in warehouses, where hiding places are more than 10' apart, or where stock movement may bump or move the trap.

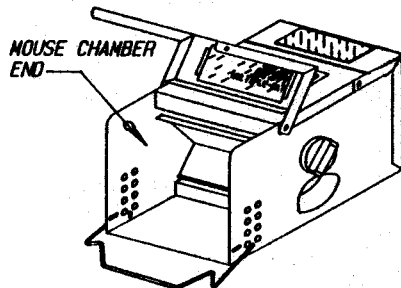


Either method works well. Method "A" has shown more multiple-catches per night than "B". However, "B" works better when mice are entering through bay door or other generally large passage ways.

4 It is easy to service the double door "MOUSE MASTER" with unmatched convenience.

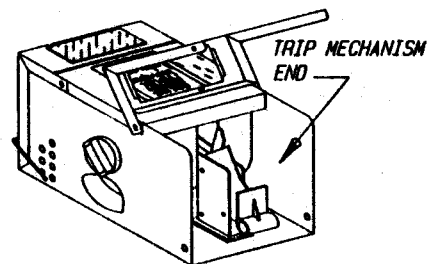
"C"

To empty the trap, release the Handle from the Slots, to allow the door to open. Remember, when cleaning the trap, the odor left by mice is the best attractant for others. Make sure the handle is firmly engaged in the Door Slots when closed.



"D"

Depress the sides of the trap near the bottom of the door to pop open. This open door allows full access for complete sanitation.



5 Be sure to monitor the "MOUSE MASTER" regularly. Shine a light through the windows to inspect the trap. Entrapped mice do not live more than 48 hours, and may be cannibalistic toward other caught mice.
